Right to Know form:

Andy Crone made a motion to bring the form “Request for Information Under the Right to Know Law” before the entire school board. This motion was seconded by Brandy Banks.

Policies:

- ❖ Mr. Tursi took Manchester’s Student Code of Conduct to assist in developing policies for Milton. Manchester’s policies have Level 1, 2, 3, 4. These levels show the action that caused the student to come before a disciplinarian and the action to be taken by the disciplinarian. Milton could do away with having six policies to address discipline issues by using a level system.
- ❖ The new policies will not be approved by the full board in time for insertion in the student handbook as the handbook is given to students on the first day of school.
- ❖ Once the full board has approved the new policies, then the policies will be placed on the website.
- ❖ Package before the subcommittee includes all RSA’s – all laws- are cited.

- ❖ School should begin having the parent's sign the student handbook as well as the students.
- ❖ A committee of 25 people, including Mr. Tursi, worked on the Student Code of Conduct for Manchester. Mr. Tursi has permission to copy and use Manchester's Student Code of Conduct handbook.
- ❖ The Policy of Passing/Retention of students will be coming and should be in place by this fall.
- ❖ Although retention of a student is not always good; it some cases it is necessary.
- ❖ Usually the principal of the school has the final decision in the Passing or Retaining of a student.

The motion to adjourn this meeting was made by Andy Crone at 5:23pm. Brandy Banks seconded the motion to adjourn.
